
Taiwan CRC price remains strong due to shortage problem

It is reported that Taiwanese downstream mills wouldn't like to stock up especially for HRC for the time being because the steel price is at a high level.

The buyers are adopting a wait and see attitude nowadays. Besides, there are some low-priced import materials.

On the contrary, CRC price remains strong due to shortage problem whose price has been TWD 4,000 to TWD 4,500 per tonne higher than HRC price.
