
Dubai Pearl completes 50pct of Towers Quartet work

Pearl Dubai FZ LLC a leading real estate developer in the UAE announced that the completion of 50% of the foundation works in the prestigious Dubai Pearl development with the completion of the raft pouring in the South Tower on the project.

The South Tower has a foundation slab which is 3.25 meters thick and 3,072 square meters in total area. Juxtaposed against the 8.07 meters excavation, the dimensions make it a major milestone in the projects construction timeline. The second raft pouring on the project was completed in a record time of 30 hours.

The overall concrete pouring on the project's 4 towers will consist of around 44000 cubic meters of concrete in the foundations containing over 4800 tonnes of steel reinforcements.

Located opposite the Palm Jumeirah Island in the heart of Dubai Technology and Media Free Zone, Dubai Pearl is a landmark destination designed to offer spectacular views of the Arabian Gulf. Through integrating first-class facilities, it will shape a pedestrian friendly, 24 hour living city boasting a spectrum of commercial, retail, residential, hospitality and leisure components.
