
OMK to increase pipe deliveries to Gazprom Neft by 30pct

It is reported that the Russian pipe producing company United Metallurgical Company has announced that its subsidiary OMK Steel has signed a strategic partnership agreement for the years 2009 to 2010 with one of the largest oil and gas producing companies in Russia, namely, Gazprom Neft.
