
Panzhuhua New Steel Vanadium starts pipe production for nuclear plants

China Metallurgical News reported that Panzhihua New Steel & Vanadium Co Ltd is now on the production of more than 3,000 tonnes nuclear power steel pipes, indicating that the company has stepped into the stage for batch production.
